The “Bad” Bills

HB24-1353: Firearms Dealer Requirements & Permits

The bill mandates that firearms dealers in Colorado obtain a state firearm dealer permit, in addition to holding a federal firearms license, to legally deal in firearms.

SB24-066: Firearms Merchant Category Code

Processors must assign a code to each firearms merchant they service. Violations are subject to a \$10,000 fine per infraction, enforced by the attorney general's office.

The Halfway Point

Earlier this month, we reached the halfway point in this legislative session. In these first 60 days, we have seen the introduction of multiple anti-gun bills and bills that will raise the cost of living for all Coloradans. As a strong supporter of both the Second Amendment and the fundamental American pursuit of being financially stable, I will be a strong NO vote on any bill that tries to take away our freedoms and liberties. Being a part of the minority, Colorado Senate and House Republicans such as myself, have our work cut out for us the rest of this session. We will do everything we can to fight for YOU!
