My Bills

SB24-161 Parks and Wildlife Licenses and Passes

This bill amends certain requirements and procedures related to licenses and passes from the Colorado Parks and Wildlife Commission. The bill lowers the age threshold for senior annual fishing licenses to 64 years of age and amends the definition of "low-income senior".

Status: Introduced and assigned to the Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee.

SB24-121 Licensure of Critical Access **Hospitals**

Rural hospitals must be licensed as general hospitals under state law and under federal law are designated as critical access hospitals. This bill allows the department of public health to license critical access hospitals separate from general hospitals.

Status: Assigned to the Senate Health and Human Services Committee.

SB24-099 PERA Employment after Retirement for Rural Schools


A rural school district may hire a retiree without the retiree receiving a deduction in benefits for any length of employment in the calendar year.

Status: Passed through the Senate. Introduced in the House and assigned to the House Education Committee.

SB24-004 County Veterans Service **Offices Administration**

The bill changes procedures for the division's payment to counties for the performance of certain veteran's services.

Status: Introduced in the House and assigned to the House State, Civic, Military, and Veteran Affairs Committee.
